A—

In 4th-Century Rome, a loosely organized, but strong contingency of Christians was gaining a political voice. Constantine considered it politically advantageous to claim Christianity. He and most of his subjects were sun worshipers, but he sought to appease the Christians...before their clout had reached critical mass. He was successful; but, at no point did he surround himself with the kinds of symbols and behaviors that might have identified him as a Christian. His royal jewelry and his clothing and the castle decor, etc., all bore the symbols of sun worship.

Through skillful manipulation of the dialog at the A.D. 325 Council of Nicea, Constantine succeeded in convincing the pompous leaders of the still-not-well-organized Roman church that they, too, could benefit from his political savvy. "After all," he may have reasoned, "if you want to convert all those heathen sun worshippers under my rule, you'd be smart to be more flexible!" And that's why, how and when the Roman church set the primary precedent for corrupting Christianity with Pagan symbols, practices and cleric attire. Later, per page 40 of *Stanley's History*, "The popes filled the place of the vacant emperors at Rome, inheriting their power, their prestige, and their titles from Paganism." The momentum and the rabid corruption of that **first weapon of mass deception** grew virtually unchecked until the early 16th Century. That's when Martin Luther and The Protestant Reformation emerged. That was a good thing, but Satan always counters good things with evil things: Some of Luther's contemporaries coveted the enormous potential for controlling followers and follower's dollars by copying the organization and the pomposity of the Roman church. That included the elevation of the clergy to a "special" status. Others, including John Calvin, were more interested in authoring new winds of doctrine than in getting back to The Original Truth. That yielded the **second weapon of mass deception**. It gained a strong footing in the early 16th Century, concurrent with the Reformation.

The **third and fourth weapons of mass deception** were born as Evil Doctrinal TWINS in the early 19th Century, at Port Glasgow, Scotland. From their Occult origin, they have slithered easily (but separately) into the mainstream of the visible Protestant church. They will continue to gain momentum until Satan – masquerading, successfully, as Jesus – is revealed for who he really is. The result? Millions of naive Christian believers and their clergy will be fully persuaded that Satan is Jesus. Soon afterward, they'll be cast into outer darkness. (Deep space?) Initially, their weeping and gnashing of teeth won't be from fire and brimstone, though. It'll be from the anguish of knowing they had worshipped the wrong "christ." (You can read what Jesus had to say about "outer darkness" at Matthew 8:11,12; 22:13 and 25:30.)

B—

Antichrist – a.k.a. Satan – will masquerade as Jesus. His masquerade will be so utterly convincing that even God's elect would fall for it if that time were not to be shortened (See Matthew 24:22 and Mark 13:20). Economic prosperity and world peace will characterize the majority of his reign. Most of Earth's people, including non-Christians, will be convinced that he is God. Their conviction will be so complete that they'll "request prayer" for their friends, neighbors and relatives who don't believe it. **Read Mark 13:12 and Luke 21:16 to learn the horrible result of those "prayer requests."** But why and how will he enjoy such enormous success in duping most of the world's Christian believers? That's because most professing Christians and their clergy appear to have already fallen victim to the grandest con ever: "Let no man deceive you by any means: for [that day shall not come], except there come a falling away first..." —Paul, at 2 Thessalonians 2:3 (Can unbelievers "fall away?")

> "...Many will come carrying the 'Jesus is Lord!' banner. If they tell you the time draws near don't follow them!" —Jesus, at Luke 21:8 (sensibly paraphrased)

Learn more about the reign of Antichrist at Matthew 24:15, Mark 13:14, Luke 2:20, 2 Thessalonians 2:4 and Daniel 11:21-24. Think you're going to escape that time? Then you're already a victim of the 3rd weapon of mass deception. (See Jesus' words at Matthew 24:10-13 and Mark 13:13.)

C—

This sequence is not conjecture. It is not even debatable by reasonable people. Jesus, himself, proclaimed this **7-Event Final Countdown**. Although He mentioned some of the calamities that have always been a part of the human experience (e.g.: earthquakes and wars), He did NOT include them as end-of-the-age "signs:"

- 1 The sun and the moon will be darkened, per Matthew 24:29, Mark 13:24,25 and Luke 21:25,26.
- 2 Stars will fall—as recorded at Matthew 24:29, Mark 13:24,25 and Luke 21:25,26.
- 3 The powers of heaven will be shaken, according to Matthew 24:29, Mark 13:24,25 and Luke 21:25,26.
- 4 And THEN Jesus will return to gather the saints: Matthew 24:30, Mark 13:26 and Luke 21:27.
- 5 Jesus will call His angels with the sound of a great trumpet, per Matthew 24:31 and Mark 13:27. This is clearly **The Last Trump** of 1 Corinthians 15:52 and 1 Thessalonians 4:16,17. It is **The Seventh Trump** of Revelation 11:15. This seventh (i.e.: the last) trumpet will sound at **The Third Woe, exactly 3½ days after The Two Witnesses are murdered**—promptly after they are resurrected. "Here's your sign:" **Revelation 11:3-14.**
- 6 The angels will gather the TARES first. The WHEAT will be "left behind" for the angels to harvest next. Don't believe it? Read it in Jesus' own words at Matthew 13:39-43.
- 7 The angels will then gather the WHEAT unto Christ. Jesus proclaimed that at Matthew 13:39-43, Matthew 24:31 and Mark 13:27. This event is called **The First Resurrection** at Revelation 20:5,6.

Seeking the "escape" they've been promised, most of the millions of today's victims of WMD #3 are looking for Jesus to come for them *early*. One who will masquerade as Jesus will come for them early—at the 6th Vial, the 6th Trump and the 6th Seal. When they finally discover that they've been conned, it will be too late for them to do anything about it. D—

Christ's 1,000-Year Reign with His Body; a.k.a. His **Bride;** a.k.a. The **Church;** a.k.a. The **Elect.** (Yes, they're all one and the same.) It will follow The First Resurrection, as recorded at Revelation 20:5,6, 1 Corinthians 15:52 and 1 Thessalonians 4:16,17.

When Jesus died, he became "the firstfruits of them that slept" (1 Corinthians 15:20). Upon his resurrection, he became the firstfruits of them that will be resurrected (1 Corinthians 15:23). As the "firstfruits" of our resurrection, **Jesus' experience is our benchmark;** i.e.: the definitive example of what our own resurrection will be like. His resurrection was NOT accompanied by "rapture." Instead, Jesus was "caught up" into a wonderful new spiritual body. In that new body, Jesus stayed right here on Earth for quite a while! That's the same "twinkling of an eye" CHANGE that those who are to be included in "the first resurrection" of Revelation 20:6 can anticipate.

> "Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be CHANGED, In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be CHANGED " —1 Corinthians 15:51,52 (You've been told that's a *different* "last" trump?)

Note: the "last trump" of 1 Corinthians 15:51,52 and the "trump of God" at 1 Thessalonians 4:16 are the trumpet of the seventh angel of Revelation 11:15. Bank it.

E—

Satan will be released again—for a short time: Revelation 20:3,7-10.

F—

The one and only Judgment is The Great White Throne Judgment of Revelation 20:11-15. There is NO scriptural distinction between that and The Judgment Seat of Christ at Romans 14:10 and 2 Corinthians 5:10.
